'Jack and the Beanstalk'

Each week pick a new activity to do. You must complete all activities by the end of the half-term.

When you have completed a piece of work please share it with me.

Choose a traditional tale (The 3 little pigs, Cinderella...) to read/watch together. Draw a picture and write about a good and bad character.	Look in your cupboards. Sort food according to its source - is it from an animal or a plant?	Find 5 different leaves. How are they the same and different?
Keep a food diary. Record foods according to which colour they are. Are there any colours you are not eating?	Draw a picture of your friends. Tell someone about them..	Find/draw pictures of different flowers. Make a collage of your favourite flowers.
Practise counting 0-20 in 1s 0-100 in 10s 0-20 in 2s	Learn your address.	Go on a bug hunt. (separate document)
