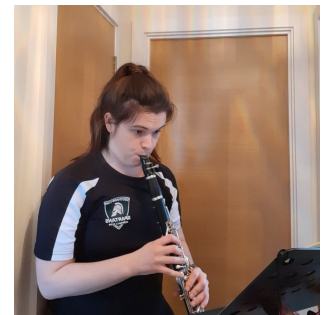
Design your own flag! Which shapes are you going to use? Which colours are you going to use?  
Tricky challenge: can you write a riddle describing your flag for your grown up or me to draw? For example, I could describe the Mexican flag like this - I have a green oblong, then a white oblong, then a red oblong. There is a brown bird in the white oblong.



I also played a board game with my family but over the internet. The game is to give a clue linking two words together so your partner can guess which cards you meant. For example, I might say "body part" to connect the tail and hand cards together.



What clue could you give to link penguin and fish?  
What 2 cards work for the clue clothes?  
Tricky challenge: choose two other cards and give me a clue to link them.



I have also been practising playing some of my favourite pieces on the clarinet.

Make your own musical instrument out of things you can find at home. For example, you could make a guitar out of a cardboard box, a flute out of a bottle or a drum out of a plastic bag and jar.

Practise and put on your own performance for your grown ups. You might want to learn a song, create a dance routine or pretend to be a character from a story.
