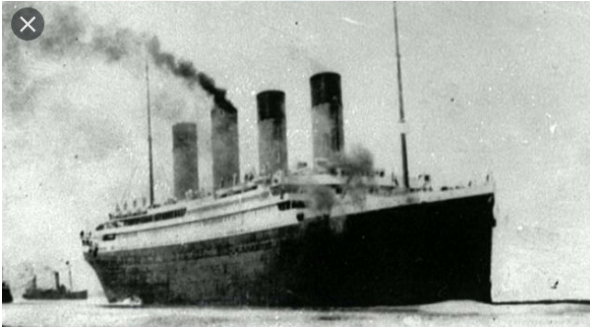

Here are some questions you might want to answer:

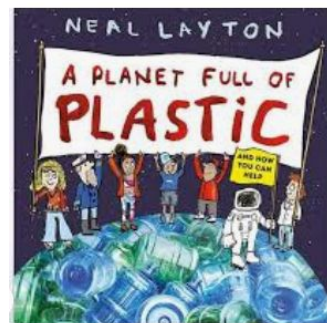
- Where was the Titanic built?
