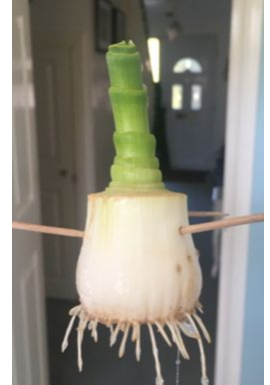

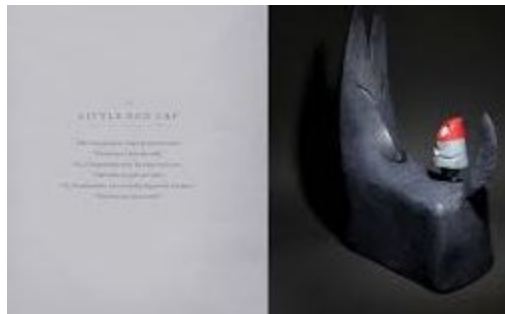
Hi Year 5!
