


Good Morning everyone!

Some of the activities I set over the next few weeks will be linked to what we would have done at school. If you want to find out any more on your own, you are more than welcome!


This week:

MangaHigh: Counting up to 100, Counting in 5s, 2D shapes, Money – Coins.

MyMaths: Understanding time, Patterns and sequences, comparing length.

LiteracyPlanet: Phonics games. These have no end date so can be played whenever. There is a big list so I recommend playing a few each time you log in.

English Challenge: The Titanic went on a long journey across the ocean. You can see it on this map. Make a map of your house and write some instructions to tell someone how to get from one room to another. For example: from the bathroom to the kitchen, or from your bedroom to the living room.



Maths Challenge: Measurement! Choose a soft toy. Look around your house and find: 3 things that are taller than your toy? 3 things that are shorter than your toy? 1 thing that is the same size? Can you put them all in order from shortest to tallest?

Topic Challenge: Science! The Titanic was a very large boat and some people were amazed that it could float. Use a big bowl of water and explore what items you can find that sink or float. What material are they made out of?

Creative Challenge: The titanic was a very impressive boat. Make or draw your own super impressive boat! If you can write down what makes it special.
