


Year R Home Challenges 13/5/2020

This week's number is 18. Count up to 18 and back to zero. Write the numbers, find 18 objects. Count out 18 blocks. Share them with teddy. How many can you have each? Can you put it on the part, part, whole diagram (see separate sheet) Make sure your child is counting carefully. If they are not – reduce the number of objects your child is counting. 1. Make a number 17 card to go with the other numbers you made. Draw the correct number of spots and the numerals on them. Get someone to hide the numbers. Can you find them in the correct order?
2. Watch this week's maths lessons at <https://www.thenational.academy/online-classroom/reception/maths#subjects> This week we are focusing on one more and one less. We are working to 20 so if your child is confident with activities to 10 then move onto 20.
3. Play a board game. Whatever number you roll on the dice you have to move 1 more. So if you roll a 5 you move 6. Play again and move one less space.
