


Year R Home Challenges 6/5/2020

This week's number is 17. Count up to 17 and back to zero. Write the numbers, find 17 objects. Count out 17 blocks. Count out 17 objects. Share them with teddy. How many can you have each? Can you put it on the prt, part, whole diagram (see separate sheet) Make sure your child is counting carefully. If they are not – reduce the number of objects your child is counting. 1. Make a number 17 card to go with the other numbers you made. Draw the correct number of spots and the numerals on them. Get someone to hide the numbers. Can you find them in the correct order?

3. Play charades – each person acts out something in the daily routine – getting dressed, eating breakfast, brushing teeth... can the others guess what you are doing and when you are doing it?



Make a game of skittles. Use plastic bottles or toilet rolls – anything from the recycling bin that you can knock over. Use a ball – or some rolled up socks. How many skittles are up and how many are down?

Fruit and vegetables grow on plants. Use the internet to find out how your favourite fruit and veg is grown. Look at a pineapple plant it is very surprising! Find a recipe using fruit or veg and help a grown up make it. It could be a fruit salad, pizza, soup..



1. Practise saying the sounds on your sound mat. Read a new digraph each day. Watch lessons 4 and 5 of the daily phonic lessons (link above and on phonic information sheet) <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ppb9We6g8BA> Practise writing oa and oo Read and write the oa and oo words.
2. Watch this Oliver's vegetables story. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=UcxnE4Xh0-g> Write a list of all the foods that Oliver found. Ask everyone in the house what their favourite vegetables are – draw a picture and write a sentence. Mum likes...
3. Choose 3 new tricky words to practise writing. Listen to the tricky word song. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=R087IYrRpgY>
4. Practise writing ladder letters in your book. Write a line of each letter. (see last week's home learning)
5. Read at least 2 books on Bug Club this week.
