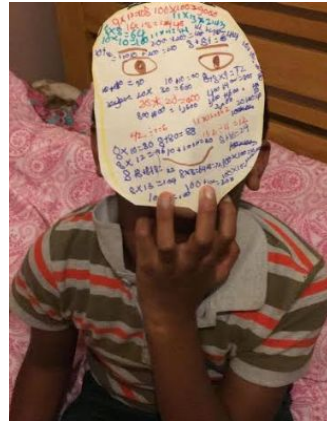
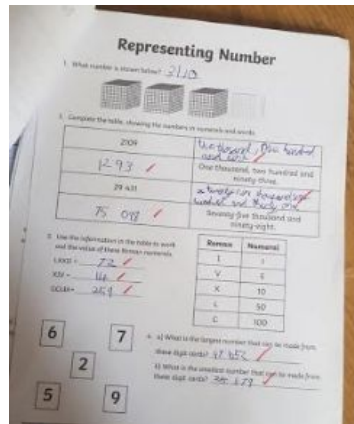
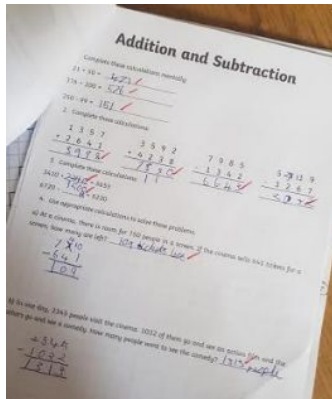


# Maths Newsletter WB 4.5.2020
