I also had a go at making some mosaics with my children like we did in school as I enjoyed it so much.



This week we're going to have a go at grouping animals according to their features and what they do.

Have a go at drawing this Venn diagram (you could draw around plates to help you):



Can you put these animals into the correct area of the diagram? Do some research if you're not sure. If they don't belong inside, you can write them outside the circles.

Creative Corner


