MangaHigh: Putting Whole Numbers in Order, More Counting in 2s, Length and Height.


MyMaths: Comparing time, Comparing Mass, Number Facts and Doubles.

EducationCity: Animals - all about sorting different animals. This links to the English and Topic about different animals. These are sequences of activities, have a go at a few at a time. Money and Capital letters and Full Stops are still available from last week.



LiteracyPlanet: Phonics games. These have no end date and there is a big list so play a few each time you log in.

English Challenge: Find out some facts about an animal that lives in the ocean. Draw a picture of it and write your facts underneath. Don't forget your capital letters and full stops! Extra challenge: Can you label different parts of the animal in your picture?



Maths Challenge: Did you know that counting in 10s can help us work out big maths problems. If a pack has 10 pencils in, how many pencils are in 2 packs? What about 3 packs? You can write it down using a new symbol X. See if you can work it out all the way up to 10 packs. Draw a picture or use something to help if you want to.



Topic Challenge: One group of animals is called fish. Pick three animals that are fish and think about what is the same and what is different about them. If you want to, you can draw pictures or write about it.



Creative Challenge: Make an under the sea picture. You could use pencils, paint, collage, chalks or anything else you have at home.
