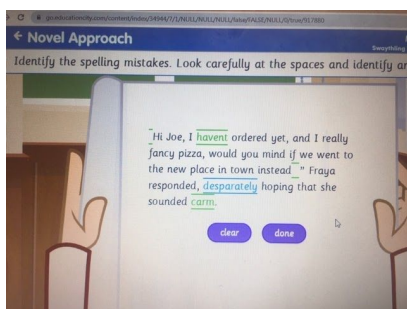


# Hello!
