


Year R Home Challenges 24/6/2020

Count up to 20 and backwards to zero. Write the numbers. Find 20 blocks. Make sure your child is counting carefully. If they are not – reduce the number of objects your child is counting.

This week we are focussing on 10. Make sure you can carefully count forwards and backwards to 10.

This week we are focusing on sharing into and counting in equal groups. You will need 10 objects and 5 containers.

1. Practise sharing objects into equal groups. You could put 8 into 4 equal groups, 10 into 2 or 5 equal groups or 12 into 3 or 4 equal groups.
2. Draw some fields on a farm. Can you put equal amounts of animals into each field? What about sharing 8 sheep into 2 fields?



Jumping – how high can you jump?
Can you jump up against a wall and see how high you can touch? How far can you jump? Can you keep trying to go as far as you can? How many jumps does it take to get across a room?

The Little Red Hen made some bread. Can you make some bread? There is a simple chapatti recipe uploaded.

Can you make a windmill like the one the Little Red Hen used?

What animals would be on a farm with the Little Red Hen? Can you draw them and write their names?



1. Practise saying the sounds on your sound mat. Read a new digraph each day. Watch lesson 17 of the daily phonic lessons with the focus on oo and ar. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=4KnggnLly00&list=PLuGr6z2H2KNG4UylwowlcDLr-T-k&index=43> This week's focus is oo as in book and ar. Practise reading and writing oo and ar words.
2. Re-watch the little red hen <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=JTCsL26vob4>
 - a. Write a sorry letter to The Little Red Hen from her friends who didn't help.
 - b. Draw a picture of the animals with a speech bubble for something they say in the story.
3. Listen to a new tricky word song. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ri4u0TjAZ38> Practise spelling the tricky words my and her. Write some sentences about what it yours and hers. "This is my...." "This is her...."
4. Practise writing ladder letters in your book. Write a line of each letter.
5. Read at least 2 books on Bug Club this week.
