### Year 3, 4 5 and 6

Can you write a timetable of what you get up to during the day. Can you write what time you start and what time you finish doing each activity? (digital time would be the best to use for this. For example 13:10 is 10 past 1 in the afternoon.  
Challenge: How long did each activity last?
