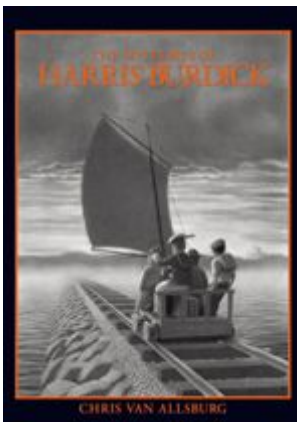


Hello Year 5!
