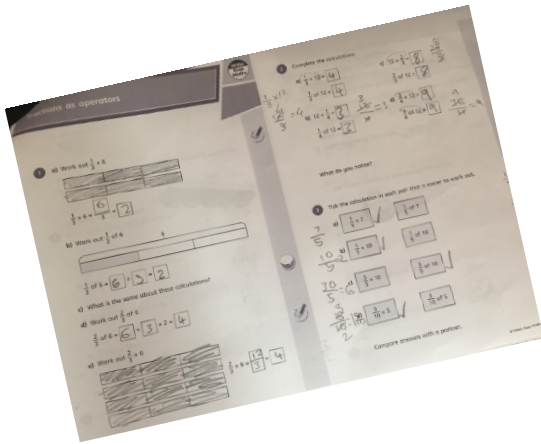

Well done to Mahika in Year 5 for completing the White Rose multiplying fractions sheets from the Maths home learning section on our school website! Great work Mahika, keep it up!



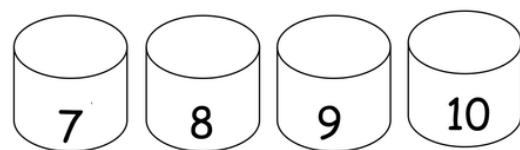
