This is all about wild things that you might find if you went out into the woods. Some of the activities I set over the next few weeks will be linked to what we would have done at school.


This week:

Have a think about these questions. Write down your answers or tell them to a grown up. Did you enjoy the story? What do you think of Max, is he a nice character or a naughty one? Do you think Max really sailed to the island of wild things?

Maths Challenge: Money! Ask a grown up to help you find some different coins to use. Have a look at both sides of each coin and see what you notice. Can you find out how much each one is worth? You could draw around them and write the number inside to help you remember what each one is. If you fancy an extra challenge pick 3 coins and add them together to see what the biggest number you can make is.

Topic Challenge: Go outside in your garden or for a walk - See if you can identify any of the different kinds of tree using the tree hunt guide.

Creative Challenge: Collect some leaves from plants outside and use them to make a picture or a pattern.
