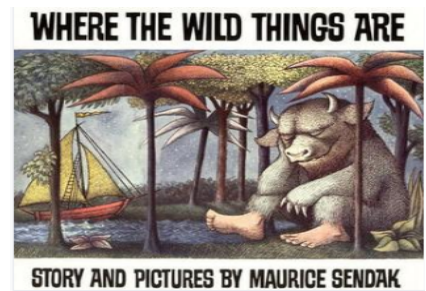


Hi all!

Maths Challenge: Sequencing events! Get a grown up to help you draw or write down parts of your daily routine on different pieces of paper. This could include things like: wake up, get dressed, brush teeth, eat dinner, have a bath. Mix them up and then see if you can put them back in order. Talk them through using time words such as first, next, before, and after.



Topic Challenge: Design your own wild thing. All of Max's wild things have sharp teeth and yellow eyes. What will yours look like? When you've finished colour it in and label its parts. Here's mine!

Creative Challenge: Instead of an arty creative challenge, this week I'd like you to put on your favourite music and do some dancing instead! Dancing can be just as creative but also is really good exercise!
