


Hello Year 5 and 6!

Can you make...

E.g $1 + 99$, $200 - 100$, 10×10 , $1000 \div 10$

Also, think a bit more creatively... e.g 0.1×1000 , $1.95 + 98.05$

Lemony Snicket

In Chapter 1 we meet the main characters, Violet, Klaus and Sunny. Violet likes to invent things, Klaus likes animals, nature and books and Sunny likes to bite things!

Task 1...

Can you design a machine (like Violet) e.g. a catapult to return stones that you have skimmed across the sea? You could even have a go at making your design out things you have around the house.

Task 2...

Have a go at pressing some leaves or flowers.

1. Put them between two pieces of paper or two pieces of material.
2. Place your flower/leaf 'envelope' between two heavy books and leave them to dry or press each one quite firmly in between the paper/material using a spoon to release the colours of the flower/leaf. (Do this one leaf/flower at a time)

In Chapter 2 we meet the character Count Olaf. His house is not very nice and is very messy. There are also lots of strange things dotted around.

Task 3...

Using the images and sheet below, have a go at writing the estate agent details to try to sell Count Olaf's house. You will need to be quite creative about how you describe the rooms and the gardens – after all, who would want to buy a house that has a kitchen full of dirty pots and pans and a garden full of rubbish. You could say something like: 'The kitchen is in need of some modernisation. It is perfect for washing up lovers who want to put their own stamp on their house' OR 'The garden offers plenty of potential and would be an ideal project for any keen gardeners. There would also be no need to ever buy 5p carrier bags again as there is a vast supply already awaiting in this garden.'
