


Hello Year 5 and 6!

Task 3...

Poisoning Count Olaf!

In chapter 3 and 4 Count Olaf orders the children to make dinner for him and his theatre troupe. The children have never cooked before so get help from the neighbour Justice Strauss by borrowing one of her cook books. They decide to cook 'Pasta Puttanesca'.

Below is the actual recipe for 'Pasta Puttanesca'. How would you change the recipe to poison Count Olaf and his friends so that the children can escape?

E.g. you could swap the capers for rat droppings, change the parmesan cheese for shavings of dry skin from an old woman's foot and you could mix some crushed up sleeping tablets in with the chilli flakes.

Why not have a go at making the real 'Pasta Puttanesca' for your tea one night to see what it tastes like.


DEPRESSING DEVICES

UNFORTUNATELY YOU ARE TRAPPED AT THE BOTTOM OF A WELL. USING THE SPACE BELOW, DESCRIBE OR DRAW AN INVENTION THAT WILL HELP YOU USING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- A CANDLE
- A PACKET OF GUM
- EYEGLASSES
- A LARGE BUCKET
- FISH FOOD
- SIX ENVELOPES
- A BOX OF RUBBER BANDS
- A PAIR OF TONGS
- THE FRENCH FLAG
- SHOELACES
- A CAN OF ROOT BEER





MAKES:

4 SERVINGS

PREP TIME:

0 HOURS **10** MINS

TOTAL TIME:

0 HOURS **30** MINS

INGREDIENTS

60 ml extra-virgin olive oil
4 cloves garlic, smashed
4 anchovy fillets, chopped
2 (400g) can chopped tomatoes
100 g kalamata olives, pitted
45 g capers
1/2 tsp. crushed chilli flakes
salt
450 g spaghetti
Chopped parsley, for garnish
Freshly grated Parmesan, for serving

DIRECTIONS

- 1** | In a large pan or pot over medium heat, heat oil. Add garlic and cook until fragrant, 1 minute. Add anchovies and cook until fragrant, another minute. Add tomatoes, olives, capers, and chilli flakes. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat and let simmer, 15 minutes.
- 2** | Meanwhile, bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Add spaghetti and cook according to package directions, until al dente; drain. Toss spaghetti in sauce. Sprinkle with parsley and Parmesan and serve.
